## Project Objectivities

- To increase the understanding and knowledge of young participants about climate change, global warming, and the EU Green Deal, through interactive workshops, discussions, and educational materials.
- To demonstrate and instill an understanding of how sports and physical activities can contribute to environmental sustainability, encouraging the adoption of eco-friendly practices in sports.
- To enable participants to develop individual action plans that they can implement in their home countries post-project, focusing on the intersection of sports, environmental sustainability, and climate action.
- To create a network of young people from different countries who are committed to environmental sustainability, facilitating ongoing collaboration and exchange of best practices even after the project's conclusion.
- To develop new tools, such as digital content, campaigns, or educational programs, that can be used to promote awareness of environmental sustainability through sports in the participants' local communities.
- To inspire and equip participants to become advocates for environmental sustainability in their communities, using sports as a platform to engage and educate others, and to drive local initiatives that support the Green Deal objectives.

- Resident of one of the participating countries: Turkey, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Lithuania, Romania, Ukraine.
- Participants are expected to be open-minded, collaborative, eager to learn and share.

- eager to share his/her knowledge, experience and culture.
- ready to involve in all stages of the project (preperation, implementation and follow-up)
- To have at least A2 level of spoken English
- Group leaders should be youth workers/youth leaders that are active in sending organization and have experience in Erasmus+ programme.

## **Travel Info**



- Please confirm your flights with us before booking them. You should buy your tickets after our confirmation.
- Don't throw any ticket or boarding pass. You will need to send all of them after the mobility. If you lose any of the tickets or boarding passes, we won't be able to reimburse you for them.
- Travel costs are refundable for participants who attend all the sessions, commit themselves fully to the activities and provide all original tickets, invoices, boarding passes and emails relating to their travel. The participants should participate also in the dissemination phase.

## What to Bring:

- Original boarding passes or bus tickets and bills.
- Comfortable clothes and shoes for workshops which we will organize indoor and outdoor atmospheres depending on weather, slippers.
- Camera and laptop you can bring on your own risk. Photos will be taken during project by participants as well and at the end of the project we will share photos with all participants and partner organizations through drive links.
- We kindly ask you to bring your country's food and beverages to present to other participants at cultural nights. It would be nice to prepare some interesting presentations about your country but not Youtube videos. You can teach your songs and dances to all participants when you will have the stage.

## Reimbusment Rules

- At the arrival, all participants must provide flight reservation, all original tickets and boarding passes. They must send by post the return tickets and boarding passes to an email address which will be provided.
- Travel costs will be reimbursed only for the cheapest means of transportation. Acceptable means of transportation for the project are: plane, bus, train, metro, shuttle or ferry, or shared taxi as a group but NOT private taxi with high costs for one person.
- We will not make any refund by cash during or after the project. No payment will be made to the participants for travel tickets before the project, and no ticket purchase will be made by us on their behalf.
- The reimbursement will be done at the end of the project by bank transfer to participants' bank accounts in Euro (€). The bank transfer fee will be your responsibility.
- Refunds may take up to 90 days after the Project mobility ends.

\*\*\* Our organization does not charge any participation fee, we don't agree with this! so we do not allow partner organizations to cover participation fees for their participants that comes to project, because a small fee may be an obstacle to participation in the program. Erasmus + does not want obstacles to the participation of all young people, everyone.



## Insurance and other info

Insurance - All participants from European Union countries need to bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) with them. You can get it for free in your country and it is amazingly useful for you whenever you travel outside of your country. Participants coming from outside of the EU should acquire travel insurance.

**No alcohol and drug policy** - It means that during the whole exchange, in our venue there won't be any alcohol and drug allowed. This includes: any hard liquor, beer, wine or any other kind of alcohol, including the alcohol during the national evenings.

Food: Chefs of the hotel are preparing meals from 6 different kitchens. So every day for breakfast, lunch and dinner you will have opportunity to choose various meals in the main dining area.

**Photography**: Participants will take video and photograph throughout the duration of the activities. Pictures will be shared on partner social network sites. Please advise us If you are okay with sharing your pictures with you on it.

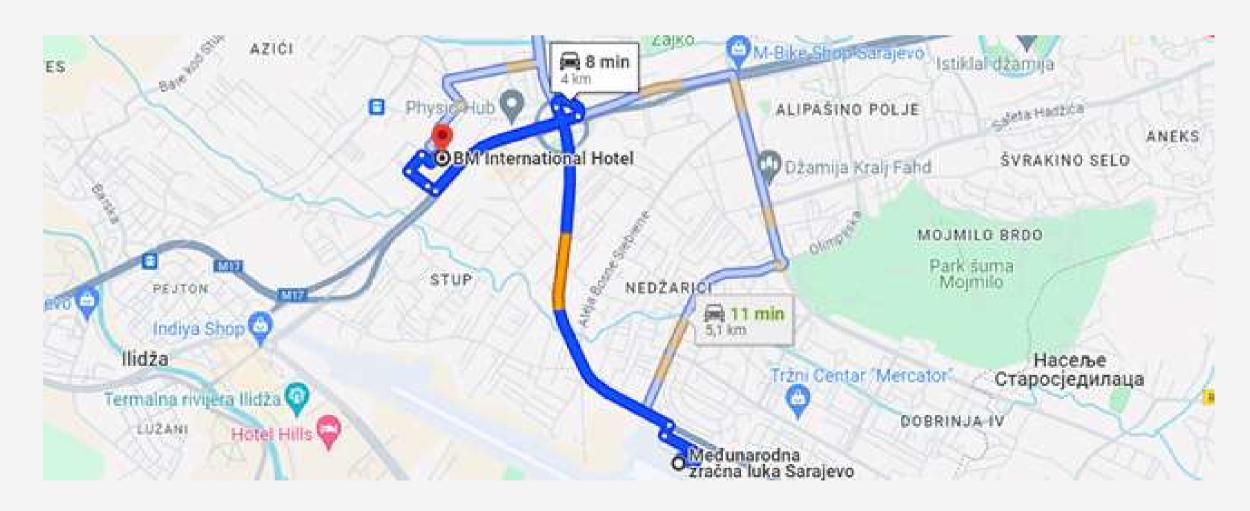




## HOW TO REACH THE HOTEL FROM AIRPORT?

If you take a taxi, it should't costs more than 10,00BM (5.00€)

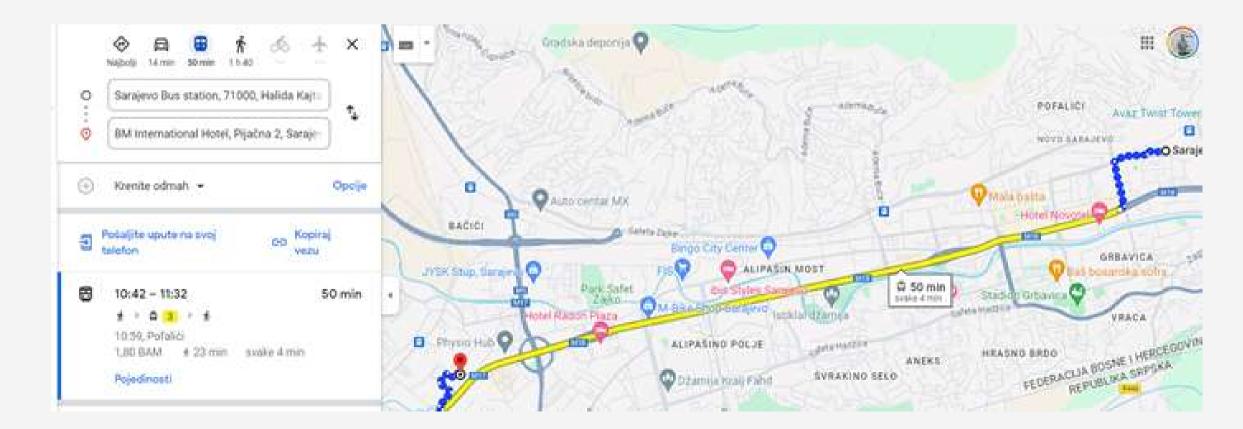


## HOW TO REACH THE HOTEL FROM AIRPORT?

#### 2-SARAJEVO BUS STATION

If you arrive to Sarajevo Bus station, you should take a tram No. 4 – and go out on the tram station called – STUP. Than walk for a 5 minutes to hotel. (Maybe this line won't work because of construction of tram lines)

Second option is to go walking to tram station called Pofalići or Muzeji (5 min walking) – then take a tram No. 3 in Ilidža direction, and go out on the tram station called STUP or ENERGOINVEST (both of them are 5 minutes walking from hotel)





## HOW TO REACH THE HOTEL FROM AIRPORT?

#### 3-BUS + TRAM + WALKING to HOTEL

Timetable:

Airport - Baščaršija: 05:30, 06:30, 07:50, 09:45, 11:30, 13:15, 15:10, 16:20, 18:00, 19:35, 21:35, 22:30.

Baščaršija – Airport: 05:00, 06:00, 07:00, 08:30, 10:25, 12:00, 13:50, 15:45, 17:10, 18:40, 20:20, 22:00.

Price of a bus ticket equals 5,00 KM, with a possibility of buying a return ticket at the price of 8,00 KM.

If you take this bus, you can go out on the bus station called Nedžarići, than take a tram to tram stop – STUP, then walk for 5 minutes to hotel.

Costs of taxi is almost the same that you will pay for BUS + TRAM (8 BAM) - taxi is 10BAM max.

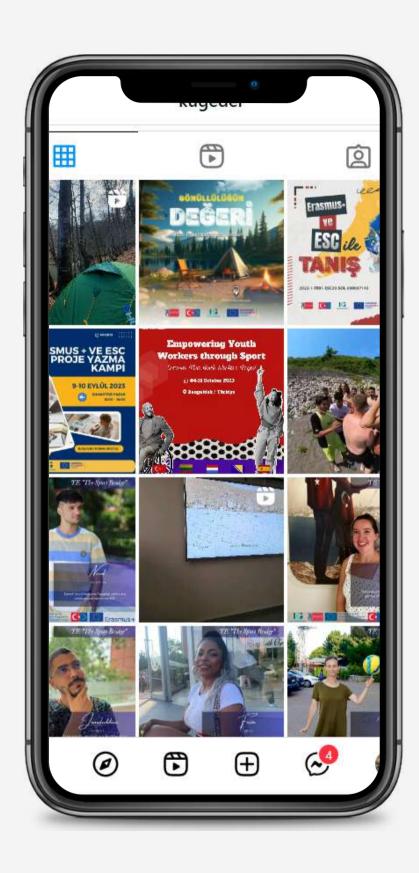
